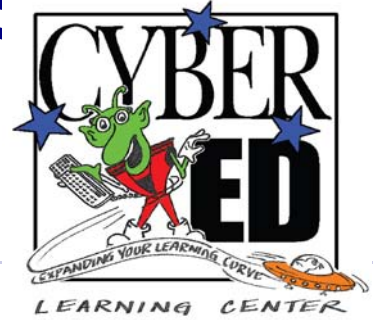

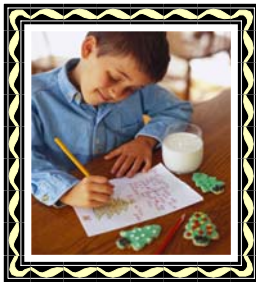
Cyber Ed will be OPEN on:
