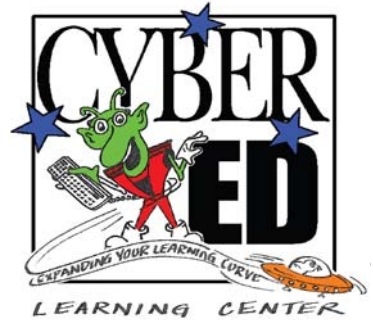

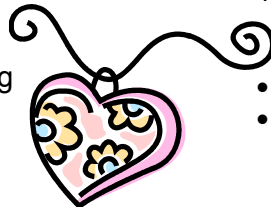


Also new is our option to pay online with your credit card (free). This new feature can be accessed through our website (www.ecybered.com) by clicking on the Pay Tuition Online button.
